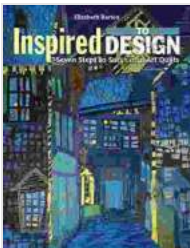

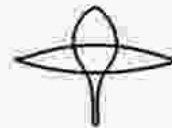
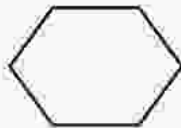
## LINE

Value describes the hue, saturation or tone within an image. Utilized to guide the viewer or to add emphasis.



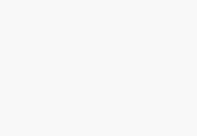
## TEXTURE

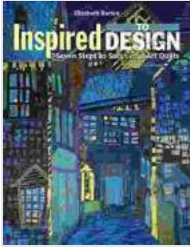




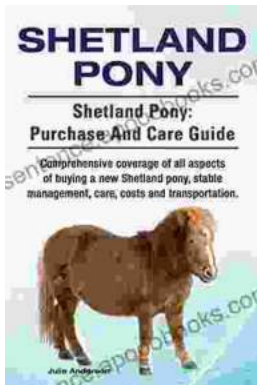

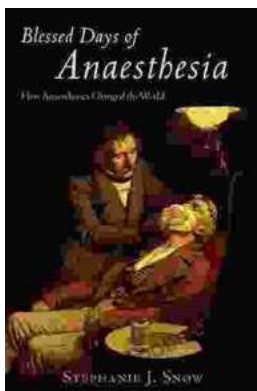
